

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS: U.S. SENATE

Project Vote Smart compiles detailed breakdowns of **campaign contributions** for elected officials and candidates at the federal and state level. The following sample data for the U.S. Senate was provided by the Center for Responsive Politics (www.opensecrets.org). PVS also maintains comprehensive, campaign contribution information pertaining to specific industries, PAC and individual contributions, as well as personal financial profiles of candidates on its web site.

Unless indicated by an asterisk (*), the six categories represent campaign data from 1997 through 2002, collected on January 27, 2002. For more recent or specific information, or information about state-level campaigns, please see the PVS web site at www.vote-smart.org or call the Voter's Research Hotline at **1-888-Vote-Smart** (1-888-868-3762). Sample campaign contribution data provided here is in the following categories:

1. **Total Contributions** - Total contributions received, as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC).
2. **Total Individual Contributions** - Total contributions made by individuals, as reported to the FEC.
3. **Total Political Action Committee (PAC) Contributions** - Total contributions made by PACs and other candidates' committees, as reported to the FEC.
4. **Total from Finance, Insurance and Real Estate PACs** - Includes banks, stock brokerage and investment firms, insurance and real estate companies, accountants, commodities brokers and all other financial services.
5. **Total from Labor PACs** - Includes all varieties of labor union PACs.
6. **Total from Health PACs** - Includes doctors and health care providers, pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, nursing homes and health service providers such as HMOs. Insurance providers are found under the Finance, Insurance and Real Estate PACs heading.
